## PRO New England Lead Safe Remodeler Policy

The PRO New England membership application requests the LSR-C license number from prospective members.

If your company does not have the LSR-C license, and your work appears to be subject to the LSR licensing requirements, PRO New England:

- Recommends that your company acquire an LSR-C license;
- Requires you to acknowledge that PRO New England has provided you with the following information and links to guide your decisions:

## **PRO New England Lead Safe Remodeler Procedure**

### **Pursuing Lead Safe Remodeler Information and Training**

PRO New England member company [LeadSmart](#), led by Peter Lawton, provides training, concierge, and consulting services to PRO New England and others on Lead Safe Remodeling and other topics. LeadSmart has training sessions scheduled throughout the year across the region. PRO New England will identify training sessions four times each the year, in different locations, that will be customized to the PRO New England audience.

Additionally, PRO New England will develop educational programming focused on safe remodeling practices, such as:

- A session focused on what is required to become an LSR-C licensed company, and then maintaining full compliance (e.g. blood testing, insurance requirements, fees, paperwork).
- A once-a-year "compliance day" that could include blood testing, a walk-through of the paperwork, filing the paperwork, or completing it online.
