CRITERIA

TradesUp, Inc. presents at least one TradesUp PRO Member Scholarship each year.

The TradesUp PRO Member Scholarship, the amount of which varies each year, is presented to a high school graduating senior who has been accepted as a full-time student to an accredited college or university in any program of study. The applicant must be the child or sibling of an employee at a current PRO New England Member Company.

The criteria used for selection may include, but are not limited to, academic achievement, community involvement, and the general essay from the application.

Candidates may apply for the TradesUp Career Kickstarter Award, the TradesUp PRO Member Scholarship, or both. The decision made by the panel of judges is final.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Please compile two copies of the following documents:

- Completed application
- School Transcript
- Activity profile or separate resume
- General Essay (250 words or fewer)
- Two letters of recommendation, (1) Teacher & (1) Personal or Employer)
- Signed Affidavit attesting that they will be entering the profession upon graduation (see last page).
